Abyssinian Oil

Crambe Abyssinica is native to the Mediterranean region and **Eastern Africa**, today known as **Ethiopia**. This plant was introduced into the United States in the 1940's and successfully grown in the northern central states chiefly in North Dakota. Abyssinian oil is **very resistant to oxidation**, unlike many plant oils, as it contains a **high percentage of C22 fatty acids**.

Abyssinian Oil contains an abundance of both Linoleic and Linolenic Acids. Linoleic Acid, an Omega 6 fatty acid, is helpful with skin regeneration, while Linolenic Acid, an Omega 3, is anti-inflammatory, cell-communicating, and skin conditioning.
